Points for Praise and Prayer

- Saturday, 2nd May marks the anniversary of the devastating Burma cyclone. Pray for the on-going work to help more than 200,000 people in Burma's Irrawaddy delta region, where around 2.5 million people continue to be affected by the disaster.
- Please pray for the people of Ethiopia during the week 3rd - 9th May. The increasing incidence of drought means that clean water is becoming more and more scarce. People are forced to use stagnant ponds as water sources, which creates risks of intestinal problems, as well as providing a breeding ground for mosquitoes.
- Praying for the 'Persecuted Church'. Pray for Christians in Tanzania and especially in Zanzibar as Muslim extremist groups try to Islamise the country, teaching the more moderate Muslim community to hate and despise those who hold fast to their Christian faith. Praise God that, despite these efforts, the Church is growing in number.
- Pray for David Allen, following his motorcycle accident on Easter Sunday. David is in the Stanmore Spinal Unit where he underwent surgery, and appears to be making a satisfactory recovery. Continue to pray for healing and wholeness.
- Along with Brian and Jenny Stutley our mission partners for April, let us remember Tim and Tricia Barrow, mission partners for the month of May who work with SIM in South Africa. Details will be on the Missions Board soon.
