POINTS FOR PRAISE AND PRAYER

"If I had cherished sin in my heart, the LORD would not have listened; but God has surely listened and has heard my prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld His love from me!" Psalm 66:18-20 (NIV UK)

Oh LORD and King what can we say? How can we praise You enough that You who know our faults so well have not rejected us, but poured out Your loving Holy Spirit on us and rescued us from the grave to be with You for all eternity. What do we need to do? Only believe and trust in Your saving message of redemption and Grace in Jesus Christ our LORD. Amen.
