FOR PRAISE AND PRAYER

"What sorrow awaits you who say to wooden idols, 'Wake up and save us!' To speechless stone images you say, 'Rise up and teach us!' Can a idol tell you what to do? They may be overlaid with gold and silver, but they are lifeless inside." Habakkuk 2:19 (New Living Translation)
